



TREATMENT SERVICES FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER (OUD)

MEASURE TYPE: Outcome

FREQUENCY OF REPORT: Monthly

DESCRIPTION: Number of unduplicated clients who have received treatment services for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) through the emergency department (ED) bridge program.

 Numerator: Total number of unduplicated clients who received treatment services for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) through the emergency department (ED) bridge program.

ICD 10 Diagnosis Codes for Opioid Use Disorder include F11.10 and F11.20

- Denominator: All clients served by the peer support specialist in the emergency department with opioid use disorder (OUD) occurring in the past one month observation period.
- Inclusions: All clients; 18 years and older for the Inclusion

DESCRIPTION: Number of unduplicated clients who have received treatment services for stimulant use disorder (StimUD).

 Numerator: Total number of clients who received treatment services for Stimulant Use Disorder (StimUD).

ICD 10 Diagnosis Codes for Stimulant Use Disorder – include F14.10, F14.20, F15.10 and F15.20

- **Denominator:** All clients served by the peer support specialist in the emergency department with Stimulant Use Disorder (StimUD) diagnosis occurring in the past one month observation period.
- Inclusions: All clients; 18 years and older for the Inclusion
- Exclusions: None



RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES RECEIVED IN THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

MEASURE TYPE: Outcome

FREQUENCY OF REPORTING: Monthly

DESCRIPTION: Number of unduplicated clients who have received recovery support services in the emergency department.

- Numerator: Total number of clients who received recovery support services (examples include intervention by peer support specialist (peer coaching), referral or linkage to treatment, referral to wrap around services).
- **Denominator:** Total number of clients with OUD and/or Stimulant Use Disorder (StimUD) who were seen by the peer support specialist in the emergency department occurring during the past one month observation period.
- Inclusions: All clients; 18 years and older for the Inclusion
- Exclusions: None
